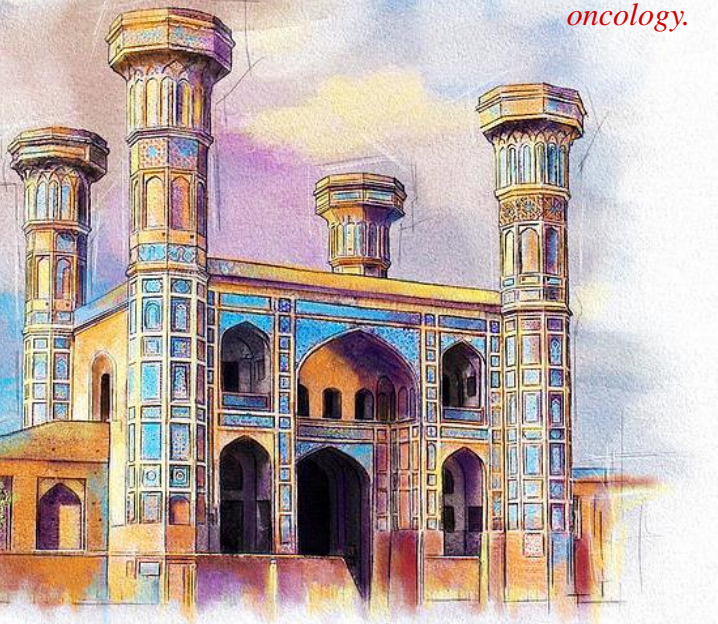

Professor Nausherwan Burki MBBS, PhD, FRCP, FRCPE, FCPS, FCCP



Dr Nausherwan Burki is Professor of Medicine at the University of Connecticut in the Pulmonary & Critical Care Division. Professor Burki has extensive clinical and research expertise in pulmonary pathophysiology, and regulation of ventilation, for which he is internationally renowned. His particular area of research is in mechanisms of dyspnoea. He has published 105 papers and chapters in scientific journals and textbooks on pulmonary physiology and medicine. He heads the pulmonary research group at the University of Connecticut working on dyspnoea. He has been a member of the working group that produced national and international guidelines on measurements of ventilatory regulation. He is a founding member of the Board of the International Network for Cancer Treatment & Research. Professor Burki has been involved with SKMCH&RC since its inception, having been responsible for the design and commissioning of the Shaukat Khanum Memorial Cancer Hospital and Research Centre in Lahore, as well as for the design, more recently, of the new Shaukat Khanum Memorial Cancer Hospital and Research Centre in Peshawar. Professor Burki also serves as a member of the Board of Governors of the Shaukat Khanum Memorial Trust.

Professor Richard J. Heald, CBE, MChir, FRCS(Ed)(Eng)



Professor Richard ("Bill") Heald is the professor of surgery at the Champalimaud Colorectal Cancer Project, Lisbon, Portugal & Pelican Cancer Foundation, Basingstoke, UK. He has spent a lifetime in developing and teaching "Total Mesorectal Excision" (TME) for rectal cancer with approximately 600 live demonstrations of TME in more than 60 countries.

He holds Honorary Fellowships in Colleges of Surgery in US, China, Germany, France, Italy, Sweden, Netherlands, Austria, Switzerland and Serbia. He is the former Vice President of the Royal College of Surgeons, England and the former President of the Association of Coloproctology of Great Britain & Ireland. Bill Heald is the embodiment of the principle that dedication, hard work, and a thorough study of one's subject will lead to improvements in patient care. His long list of honors and awards attests to the esteemed international reputation he enjoys among his peers. He also has close to 150 peer-reviewed publications in surgical literature, principally in the field of colorectal surgery. In addition to his teaching and publishing, he has participated in countless workshops, named lectures, postgraduate courses, master classes, and video productions worldwide.

Professor Ghulam J. Mufti DM, FRCP, FRCPath



Professor Ghulam J Mufti is Head, department of Haematological Medicine at Guy's, King's and St Thomas's hospitals, King's College London, with a team of 13 professors, 6 senior lecturers and approximately 100+ research staff. In addition, Professor Mufti is the Clinical Director of Laboratory Sciences and a non-executive Director of King's College Hospital, NHS Foundation Trust.

Professor Ghulam Mufti has extensive clinical and research expertise in leukaemias and lymphomas and is internationally renowned expert in myelodysplastic syndromes (MDS). He has published more than 500 papers in high impact peer reviewed journals and has written chapters in scientific journals and textbooks on leukaemias and MDS.

He is a founding member and chair of the UK MDS Forum. He is also a member of the European Bone Marrow Transplantation Group and a founding member of the Board of the International Myelodysplastic foundation, for which his department at King's College Hospital is a recognised centre of excellence. Additionally, the department is also a centre of excellence for Leukaemia Lymphoma Research and is the largest allogeneic bone marrow transplant centre in the UK, and the only gene and cell based therapies centre for myeloid leukaemia and allied diseases.

KEYNOTE SPEAKERS

Professor Larry Hadley, MB,ChB, FRCS



Dr. Hadley is Emeritus Professor in Paediatric Surgery at the Nelson Mandela School of Medicine in Durban, South Africa and a Fellow of the University of KwaZulu-Natal. He is a Past President of the International Society of Paediatric Surgical Oncology and Honorary Member of the South African Children's Cancer Study Group. He is also a Past President and Honorary Life Member of the South African Association of Paediatric Surgeons. He has written extensively on paediatric surgical oncology in countries with limited resources. He has served as Visiting Professor and External Examiner to many medical schools in Africa and around the world and acted as Examiner in Paediatric Surgery to the Colleges of East Central and Southern Africa, and South Africa.

Professor Mumtaz Jamshed, MBBS, M.D.



Dr. Mumtaz Jamshed Khan is Professor of Otolaryngology Head & Neck Surgery and Director of the Head and Neck Cancer Program at Aga Khan University in Karachi. He completed his residency and fellowship training from Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit, Michigan and Vanderbilt University in Nashville, Tennessee. He served as Director of Head and Neck Surgery at Henry Ford Hospital and also worked at the Head and Neck Institute at the Cleveland Clinic before returning to Pakistan and rejoining Aga Khan University last year. He also served as the Associate Dean of Postgraduate Medical Education at Aga Khan University. His clinical interest lies in minimally invasive, organ preservation surgery for Head and Neck cancers, skull base surgery and microvascular reconstructive surgery.

Professor Anuja Jhingran, M.D., FACR



Dr. Anuja Jhingran is Professor of Radiation Oncology in the Section of Gynecology at The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center. Dr. Jhingran is heavily involved with the Radiation Therapy Oncology Group (RTOG) and Gynecologic Oncology Group (GOG), in the development of patient care studies to treat gynecologic cancers and has been the national Principal Investigator of several studies, including a phase III study in cervical cancer. Dr. Jhingran is also an active member of the Gynecologic Cancer InterGroup. Dr. Jhingran travels extensively internationally for cancer education. She is passionate about women's health issues and especially as it relates to developing country's efforts to establish improved healthcare for the general populace, not just the financially able.

Professor Anais Malpica, M.D.



Dr. Anais Malpica is Professor of Pathology at The University of Texas M.D. Anderson Cancer Center. She received her M.D. degree from the Universidad Central de Venezuela in Caracas, Venezuela, and completed both Anatomic and Clinical Pathology residencies at Boston University and Baylor College of Medicine. This was followed by a fellowship in Surgical Pathology at The University of Texas M.D. Anderson Cancer Center. She was the former Director of the Gynecologic Pathology Section and Gynecologic Pathology Fellowship Program at MD Anderson. Dr. Malpica has authored and co-authored 220 scientific articles, 11 book chapters, and 2 books on gynecologic pathology. She is a member of the editorial board of the "International Journal of Gynecological Pathology" and "Archives of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine".

Dr. Mansoor R. Mirza, M.D.



Dr. Mansoor is Chief Oncologist at Rigshospitalet, Copenhagen University Hospital, Denmark. He also is the Medical Director: NSGO (Nordic Society of Gynaecologic Oncology), Vice-Chairman: DGCG (Danish Society of Gynaecologic Oncology), Board of Directors: GCIG (Gynecologic Cancer Inter Group) and is involved in the management of gynaecologic cancers. He is author and principle investigator of several phase I, II and III studies and chair of Independent Data Monitoring Committee (IDMC) of several international trials. He is senior author of national guidelines for the management of endometrial cancer, cervical cancer, vulvar cancer and non-epithelial ovarian cancer as well as of NSGO radiotherapy guidelines for cervical and vulvar cancers. He is invited speaker at several international meetings, including keynote lectures and serves in multiple global advisory boards.

KEYNOTE SPEAKERS

Professor Amjad Parvaiz MBBS, FRCS, FRCS



Professor Parvaiz is a specialist colorectal surgeon with comprehensive training in general, colorectal and laparoscopic surgery. He holds the position of Professor of Surgery at Poole, as well as Head of Minimal Access and Robotic Colorectal Surgery at the Champalimad Foundation in Lisbon, Portugal. He has a special interest in colorectal cancer and benign diseases. During his previous role at Portsmouth Hospital NHS Trust, he was actively involved in medical education and clinical skills training. His work at the National and International level was recognised and he was awarded a Chair in Surgery by the University of Portsmouth in 2011. Prof. Parvaiz became a pioneer in developing the Robotic Colorectal Surgery programme at Portsmouth and is an international proctor for Robotic colorectal surgery and has trained surgeons across Europe and beyond. He is Co-Director and founding member of the European Academy of Robotic Colorectal Surgery (EARCS). His clinical outcomes are published in various peer-reviewed journals.

Prof Steve Pennington Ph.D.



Steve has been Professor of Proteomics at University College Dublin (UCD), Ireland since 2003. He is a chemist and biochemist by training (BSc Imperial College London and PhD, University of Cambridge). His research interest and activities are joined by a common theme of measurement of protein expression and function on a comprehensive proteomics scale to support improved understanding of mechanisms of disease progression and diagnosis in oncology and inflammatory disease. Steve has given over 150 invited presentations at international events, published over 75 scientific papers as well as editing and contributing to several books including editing one of the first books on Proteomics that was translated into Chinese and Japanese. He is on the editorial board of several journals and regularly reviews manuscripts and grants for a number of international organisations.

Professor Asif Rashid, MBBS, Ph.D.



Dr. Asif Rashid, is a Professor of pathology and section chief of the Gastrointestinal and Liver Pathology Section at the University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center (Houston). Following graduation with an MBBS degree from the Dow Medical College, Karachi University in Pakistan, Dr Rashid completed a PhD at Boston University School of Medicine (Boston, Massachusetts), then residency training in anatomic pathology at Massachusetts General Hospital, Harvard University (Boston), followed by fellowships in surgical pathology at Massachusetts General Hospital and in gastrointestinal (GI) pathology at Johns Hopkins Hospital, Johns Hopkins University (Baltimore, Maryland). In addition to his interest in GI and liver pathology, his research interests include genetic and epigenetic alterations in premalignant and malignant tumors of the GI tract, liver, biliary tract, and pancreas. Dr Rashid is also currently a section editor in Hepatopathology for the Archives of Pathology & Laboratory Medicine.

Professor Sten Vermund, M.D., Ph.D.



Professor Sten Vermund directs the Vanderbilt Institute for Global Health and serves as the Vice President for Global Health at Vanderbilt University Medical Center. As an infectious disease epidemiologist and pediatrician, his work focuses on diseases of resource-limited settings, especially HIV, HPV, and parasitic diseases. He has led international HIV care, treatment and prevention projects in several countries, and spearheaded efforts to ease the burden of tropical and childhood diseases through research and teaching in low and middle income countries (LMIC). His recent fieldwork has emphasized HIV prevention clinical trials and cervical cancer prevention. He has published 550 original research papers, reviews, and chapters and his work is funded through six grants from the U.S. National Institutes of Health and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
